John 17 records a prayer by Jesus right before He was betrayed in the Garden of Gethsemane and handed over to be crucified. This prayer is typically divided into three sections. John 17:1-5 is Jesus' prayer for Himself, John 17:6-18 is Jesus' prayer for His disciples, and John 17:20-26 is Jesus' prayer for all those who would believe in Him (which includes you, if you have believed in Jesus unto salvation.)

Read Jesus' prayer for all those who would believe in Him (John 17:20-26). What is Jesus' prayer for you? What does Jesus want for you?

Are you living in such a way that your actions and the attitude of your heart are an answer to Jesus' prayer for you?

What is one specific thing you can begin doing now to grow in your prayer life?
